

TACKERS Camp

Privacy Policy Terms and Consent

Introduction

TACKERS Camp is a winter sports camp facilitated by Swisstransplant for children from around the globe who have had transplants. The objective of the camp is that children not only have the chance to ski but also make new contacts and mix with like-minded children. Another objective of the TACKERS Camp is to promote public awareness of the topic of organ donation and transplantation.

In order to ensure the best possible medical care for the participants, apart from contact details, medical data of the participants must be provided upon registration for the camp, in particular information of importance with regard to the transplanted organ.

Type of data

Upon registration for TACKERS Camp, exclusively data which is essential for the medical care of the children and the facilitation of TACKERS Camp will be collected. The necessary data can be taken from the registration forms "Child information", "Medical information", "Insurance information" and "Travel information". To this extent, the contact details of the participants in particular, but also details of their contact persons, and details about the participants' insurance and their health records that are of importance with regard to the transplanted organ are processed.

The required health records are indispensable for the medical care of the children with transplants. For this purpose, information with regard to the daily administration of medication, the general health condition of the child and additional information of the medical advisor is required.

The participants and their parent or legal guardian are responsible for the completeness and accuracy of the data.

Privacy protection

All data gathered is used exclusively by Swisstransplant within the context of facilitating TACKERS Camp, is handled confidentially and it is not supplied to third parties.

The right is reserved to its supply to third parties for the provision of essential medical treatment and in accordance with the mandatory applicable legal provisions.

Rights to access, rectification and erasure of the data, within the scope of data protection law, are ensured.

The data is stored in paper and electronic form. The data will be erased 12 months after the conclusion of TACKERS Camp provided that the erasure is not in opposition to the justifiable interests of Swisstransplant. A justifiable interest exists in such cases where the storing of the data serves the purpose of settling any disputes and giving of evidence.

In cases where children that have already been registered withdraw their participation, their personal data is promptly erased.

Publication

An objective of the TACKERS Camp is to promote public awareness of the topic of organ donation and transplantation. For this reason, the possibility exists that journalists will be on site, interview individual participants and take photos at not only certain larger events, for example at the ski races, but also during playtime events in the lodges – and also report on TACKERS Camp in the media. Reporting will take place in both classic and online media. Pictures where participants are identifiable may also form part of the reporting. Despite commensurate precautions, the reuse of the pictures by third parties cannot be precluded.

Applicable law and jurisdiction

In relation to disputes with TACKERS Camp or this declaration, Swiss law applies exclusively. The exclusive court of jurisdiction is Bern
